Coffee Breaks

Lunch Breaks

Lunch is offered daily in the Roof Garden Cafe' at the University Student Club (north gate) located just besides the Conference Venue. Lunch coupons (one for each day) will be given to delegates and exhibitors upon registration.

Social Events

Entrance to all social events will be via coupons that will be given to all delegates, exhibitors and accompanying persons upon registration.

How to reach the Welcome Reception location Tuesday June 28th, 2022

- Teloglion Foundation is within walking distance from the Conference Venue.
- Teloglion Foundation can be easily reached also by taxi for those coming from their hotel.

How to reach the Conference Banquet location Thursday June 30th, 2022

- Free bus transfer will be provided to all delegates and exhibitors, departure at 19:30, from the Conference Venue and from the Aristotelous Square to the banquet hall Bon Chateau.
- Bon Chateau can be easily reached also by taxi, approximately 15-20€.

Oral Presentation Guidelines

- Oral presentation slots will be strictly 20 minutes long (15 minute presentation and 5 minutes for questions).
- For presentations before the lunch session, the presentations must be loaded onto the PC in the allocated session room the evening before or prior to the morning plenary session.
- For presentations after the lunch session, the presentations must be loaded onto the PC in the allocated session room before proceeding to lunch.
- The presentations should be in PowerPoint (Windows based operating system). We cannot guarantee other formats and operating systems.

- Please take time to introduce yourself to the person chairing the session.
- Names of chair persons are given in the Conference Programme.
- The meeting will be utilizing 16:9 aspect ratio projectors (widescreen) in all rooms. To utilize the full screen, you should create your presentation in “widescreen” format. The standard 4:3 format will work but it will not fill the entire screen when in presentation mode.

Posters

- The maximum size of a poster is A0 (841mm × 1189mm or 33.11" × 46.81") in portrait format.
- The material required to attach the posters onto the panels will be provided by the conference organisers. Avoid using your own scotch tape.
- The poster exhibition is located in foyer – 1, each poster will be mounted on the poster stand with the corresponding poster number on Monday, 27 June 2022, 11:00-18:00, Tuesday, 28 June 2022, and Wednesday, 29 June 2022, all day.
- Poster (slot) numbers will be given upon registration.
- Poster demounting on Thursday June 30th the latest by 19:00.
- Poster Prizes are foreseen for the best poster as well as for the best poster by a young scientist. The prizes will be awarded during the Conference Banquet.
- Poster presenters, who will attend in person, are invited to briefly (max 3 minutes) introduce their poster in the last session on Tuesday 28 June in Room A.

Exhibition

The Exhibition is located in foyer – 1 during the whole conference.

Updates to the programme and any additional information will be announced on the information board near the registration desk.

Updates will be also inserted in the General Information accessible via the Internet.

Internet Access

The conference will provide free WLAN Internet access all over the Conference Venue. Each registered participant will be given an individual password.
